

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR HIVE TOP FEEDER

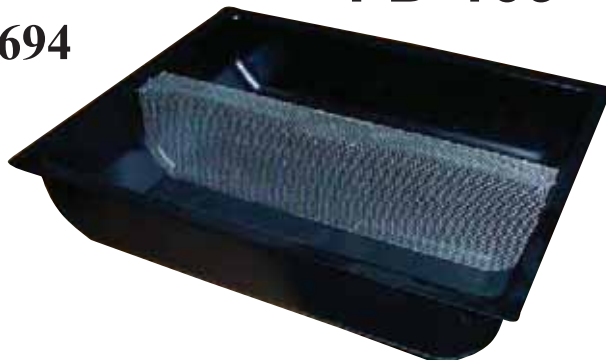
Included in box:

- Top Feeder Insert
- 3 Phillips Head Screws
- 1 Screen

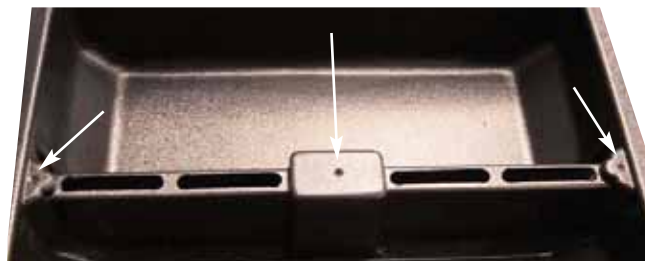

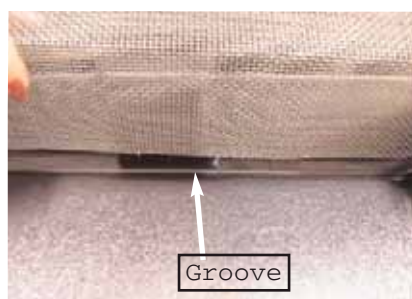
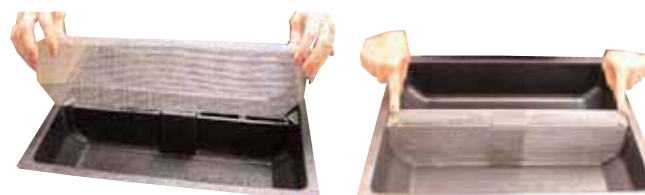
Tools needed to assemble Top Feeder Insert:

- Phillips Screwdriver
- Needle Nose Pliers

There are 3 screw ports on the top feeder insert. The arrows indicate where the screws need to be inserted. Note location before placing the screen. (Pictured on right.)



Take the screen and place it over the center divider of the top feeder insert. (Pictured on right.)



Make sure the screen fits down firmly into the groove at the bottom of the top feeder insert. (Pictured on left.) The screen must be centered properly on top of the insert so there is equal amounts on both ends of the feeder to prevent bees from gaining access to the reservoirs.

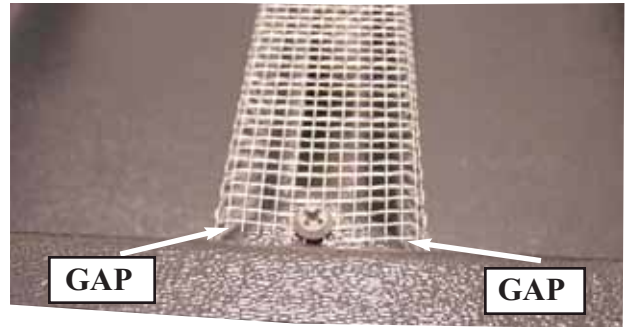
Next you will take your phillips head screwdriver and apply one screw into the center screw port on the insert. Use pressure when screwing and turn until the screws is tight in the plastic and will not turn anymore. (Pictured on right.)





Now insert a screw on the left and right side of the feeder in the same fashion. (Pictured on right.)

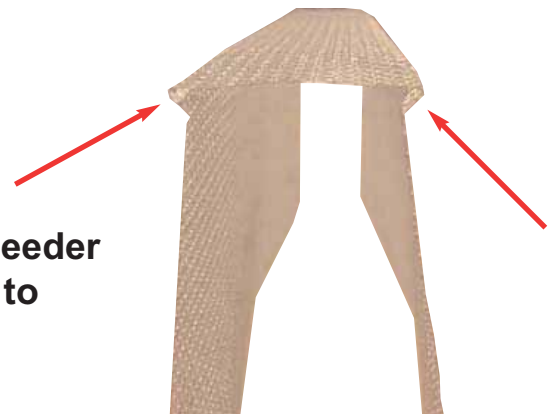
Note: If there is a gap in the ends of the screen (as pictured on right) you will need to use a pair of needle nose pliers to pinch the corners of the screen. (Do not try to pinch the screen with your fingers this can cause injury.) Any gap will allow bees to squeeze through screen and into the feeder which causes drowning.



If there is a gap use your pliers and pinch the wire of both sides of the screen to make a bee tight corner. (Pictured on left.)

You may also choose to run a bead of silicon around the groove of the sides and bottom of the screen this can help to secure the screen even more. To clean the top feeder you will want to use a pressure washer do not scrub where the silicon is at this can cause it to come off or make the area sticky.

Picture on right shows screen after the ends are pinched.
