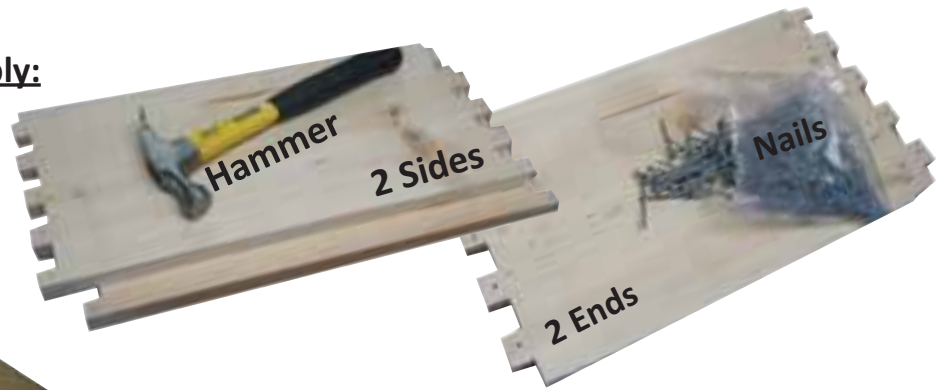


# Assembling Your Hive Body & Super

## What you will need for Assembly:

- 2 Ends
- 2 Sides
- Hammer
- Nails (sold separately)
- Construction Square



## Step One:

Take 1 side and 1 end and put the fingers together. Make sure your hand holds are facing up and facing out.



## Step Two:

Put nails into the pre-drilled area on fingers before nailing the final side/end put a construction square onto each in side corner of the box. A box that is not square will not sit properly on the hive. Once square pound in your nail.



## Step Three:

Repeat steps one and two.

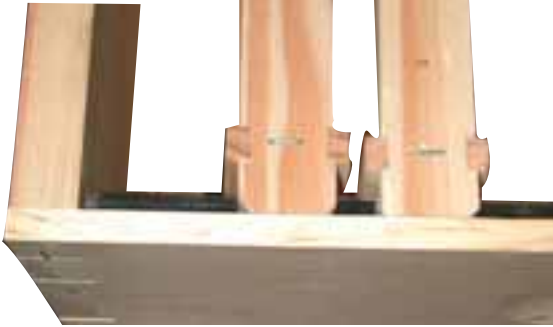

**\*Once assembled you should treat the inside and outside with a primer or paint. Only treat to the frame rest on the inside.**
