

10" X 13" 1 GALLON SYRUP *Baggie Feeder*



Simple and Cost-Effective Feeding

Just slice, sip, and let the bees slurp up their syrup buffet with a baggie feeder!

Baggie feeders are 10"x13" plastic bags filled with syrup and placed inside a feeder shim on top of the brood chamber. Beekeepers make small slits in the bag to allow bees to access the syrup without drowning.

Placement: Inside the hive, under a feeder shim

Accessibility: Small slits in baggie with minimal drowning risk

Capacity: 1 Gallon Liquid Syrup
