

DC-694 | Asian Hornet Shield

1. Lay Hornet Shield flat on table to start. (Figure 1).

2. Fold up 2 adjacent panels and put the 2 male plastic posts from the one panel through the 2 round holes on the adjacent panel. (Figure 2)

3. Take one push-washer and slide it all the way down over the plastic post to secure the 2 pieces together. Repeat for the other plastic post. (Figure 3)

4. Repeat step 3 for securing the other 3 corners with 2 washers per corner. You will now have formed a box with 4 sides locked in place.

5. Take the plastic skirt with the “Hornet Shield” logo on it and attach to front, bottom of unit and secure using 3 more push-washers to hold skirt in place. Hornet shield assembly is now complete.

6. Bend top flange up and attach to box using staple gun, applying 1 staple on each of the 3 square tabs.

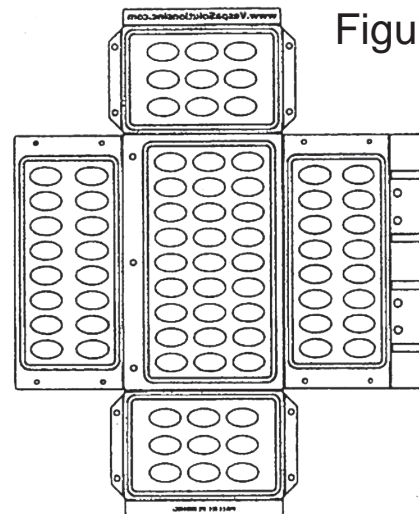

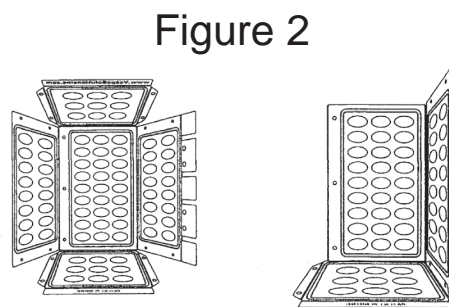

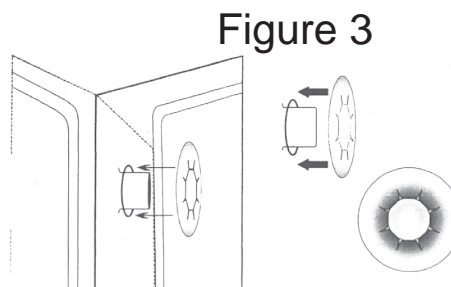
